Please make sure that **ALL** payments made are in named and sealed envelopes and are put in the silver post box on the wall outside the School Office. **We will not take money directly over the counter.**

We still have spaces available in our Breakfast Club. We charge £1.00 per day, per child and this includes toast, cereal and fruit juice.
