

# Where does bread come from?



Grain is harvested in the summer using combine harvesters.

The grain is then milled. It is ground between stones or steel rollers until it is ground into flour dust.

The flour is then sieved to remove bran. The result is fine flour.

Flour is taken to bakeries or sold in stores. Yeast and water are added to make a dough. The dough is allowed to rise and become spongy before baked.

The end result after baking in the oven is BREAD!


