### A few reminders

- Children do not need to bring bags into school. We are trying to reduce the amount of things in classrooms or hung on hooks. Everything they need for their learning is provided, so they only need to bring a bottle of water, coat and lunch box (if not have a school dinner).
- Please do not arrive early or late. We are trying to reduce the number of children entering via a gate at any one time, and the number of parents waiting by the gate. Therefore if you start time is 8:45am, please do not arrive any earlier than 8:40am. If your start time is 9:00am, please do not arrive any earlier than 8:55am. We will make sure the gates are open 5 minutes before the start time .
- All parents should be socially distancing whilst waiting to drop off and pick up. Dorothy Grove and the car park are small areas, so if you arrive at the right time it makes keeping your distance possible.

### REMEMBER



Please be mindful of your parking, residents who live close to the school need access to their driveways so please do not block them in and **DO NOT** bring your car onto Dorothy Grove. This is where parents wait and children are entering/leaving school. The road is very narrow and I do not want anyone to have an accident.
