As Readers we will:

- Listen to a range of stories

- Read simple sentences using our phonic knowledge and discuss what we have read.

As Authors we will:

- Use our phonic knowledge to write simple sentences.
- Orally retell and create stories.
- Learn about characters, settings and the sequencing of stories.

As active learners we will:

- Practice how to use tools and resources for cutting, sticking and writing.
- Use our bodies to move and respond to a variety of different sounds and actions.
- Investigate how exercise and moving can affect our bodies.

In PSED we will:

- Learn how to take care of loving things and our environment
- Appreciate that we all have different ideas, thoughts, feelings and preferences and that we must respect these difference.
- Discuss the importance of hygiene routines and precautions to stay safe.
