### Welcome

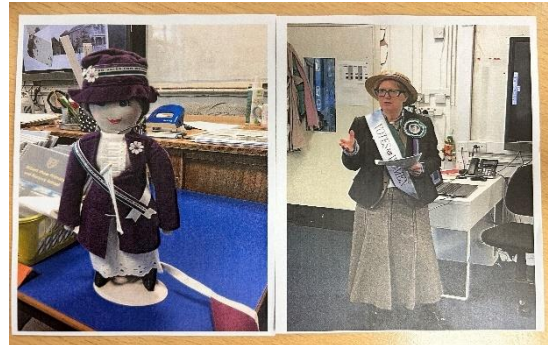
We would like to welcome Connor to the Robert Shaw team. He will be delivering PE and after school clubs.
