This was due to a lot of illnesses and parents deciding to book holidays during term time. However, there have been more children in school over the last couple of days, with the percentage going to 94.4% on Wednesday 6th November. The minimum percentage should be 96% and I hope that we can encourage all parents/carers to support their children to increase their attendance percentage.
