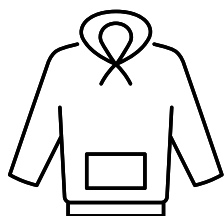
UPDATES AND REMINDERS

COLLECTIONS LIST

You may have seen our Dojo posts in relation to the end of day collections list and lunch time collections of your children.

As a reminder, we need the full name and relation of any person able to collect your child at the end of the school day. It is your responsibility to keep us up to date of any changes to this, including people who need to be removed or added.

For any collections that are a one-off, a message to the School Office on Class Dojo will be fine as long as it contains the full name of who is collecting, and we are told in plenty of notice.

For lunch time collections of children who go home for dinner, we are now only allowing the main parent/carers to collect, regardless of who is on the end of day collection list. Thank you for your continued support.
