EID AL-FITR SCHOOL MEAL

On Monday 23rd March we will be having a themed school meal to celebrate Eid Al-Fitr with the children.

If your child USUALLY has a school meal, they will automatically have this dinner on the day. If your child USUALLY has a packed lunch and would like the Eid Al-Fitr Dinner, please let the School Office know by sending us a Dojo Message before the cut off date of Friday 13th March.

If you order this meal and your child changes their mind, we will NOT be able to issue a refund as this a special menu and food is ordered in according to numbers.

The price of the meal for Yr 3, 4, 5, 6 is £2.50 as per usual (unless you are entitled to Free School Meals). For Rainbows, Sunshines, Yr 1 and Yr 2 - this is free under the Universal Free School Meal scheme.

If your child USUALLY has school meals, this cost will be included in your usual weekly bill.

If you pay for your child's school meals and they USUALLY have a packed lunch, we will raise a separate payment for this meal and you MUST make sure this is paid for when it is raised on School Gateway, after they have had the meal.

Mrs Amoabil would like to thank the children in the choir for their commitment and their families for supporting with arrangements for these events.

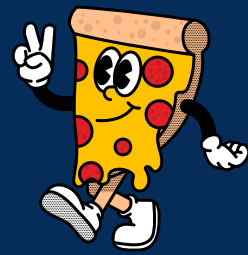

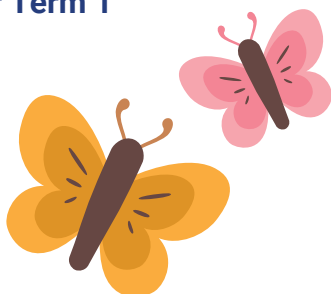
